Funding Dirigo Health Agency Administrative Expenses	 General Administrative expenses, excluding MQF may be covered with the initial one time state money and may not be covered by the Savings Offset Payment. IFS may report out a bill related to funding administrative expenses to the Second Regular Session of the 122nd Legislature.
